Conductor Steven D. Davis is a versatile and cosmopolitan leader who has inspired ensembles worldwide. In high demand as a guest conductor, he has worked across four continents, in cities such as Bangkok, Beijing, Lisbon and Sydney, while regularly conducting in Kansas City.

Davis is known for breaking barriers by leading performances in diverse genres, including wind ensembles, orchestras, opera, ballet and new music. He is a professor of conducting and conductor of the Conservatory Wind Symphony at the University of Missouri-Kansas City, where he has fostered numerous collaborations with other arts.

He is in his sixteenth season as conductor of the Youth Symphony of Kansas City's Symphony Orchestra, which has performed at prestigious events and on its 2016 Ireland Tour. Davis also serves as resident conductor of newEar, Kansas City's premier new music ensemble, and is a faculty member at Interlochen Summer Arts Camp.

He annually hosts the Kansas City Conducting Symposium and has received many awards and honors in his field.

Raffaele Cipriano is an esteemed Italian conductor, opera coach and composer, excited to work with the Youth Symphony of Kansas City and guide young musicians in learning masterpieces of symphonic literature.

Trained at the prestigious Conservatories of Padua and Venice, he excels in orchestral conducting, collaborative piano, opera repertoire and composition. In 2015, he pursued a doctorate in orchestral conducting at The University of Kansas, mentored by Maestro David Neely, graduating with honors in 2018. Cipriano has garnered acclaim through collaborations with esteemed organizations like Lawrence Arts Center, Lawrence Opera Theater and Landlocked Opera. He served as assistant/cover conductor at Sarasota Opera and currently holds the position of assistant conductor for the Topeka Symphony Orchestra. He has recently joined the music faculty at Washburn University as a lecturer and Director of Orchestra.

"Notable achievements include music direction for Romeo and Juliet, Cinderella and Carmen for Lawrence Opera Theater, conducting A Chorus Line in Topeka and guest conducting the Springfield Symphony. Based in Kansas City, Cipriano is the music director and conductor of the Overland Park Orchestra and serves as music director at the Good Shepherd Catholic Church in Shawnee.



Michelle Davis is a recently retired string orchestra educator with 32 years of teaching experience in Illinois, Michigan, and Missouri. She taught orchestra at the elementary, middle, and high school levels, most recently serving as the conductor of the Liberty High School Orchestras in Liberty, Missouri. Currently, she is the conductor Youth Symphony of Kansas City Philharmonic Orchestra, Harmony Project Encore Orchestra, and interim Professor of String Pedagogy at University of Missouri Kansas City Conservatory. She also maintains a private violin/viola studio.

Michelle previously taught beginning strings and junior high orchestra in Oak Park, Illinois, and middle school orchestra in Farmington Hills, Michigan. She also served a two-year term as Orchestra Vice President for the Missouri Music Educators Association.

An experienced clinician and guest conductor, Michelle has worked with school districts across Missouri and presented sessions at state and national conferences, including the Michigan Music Conference and the American String Teachers Association (ASTA) National Conference. In 2008, she was honored as Liberty Public Schools' "Teacher of the Year."

Michelle holds a bachelor's degree in viola performance and a master's degree in music education from the University of Michigan. She is an active member of the Suzuki Association of the Americas (SAA), the National Association for Music Education (NAfME), and ASTA. She lives in Liberty with her husband, Steve, and their two goldendoodles, Maddy and Henri.

Amanda Kremer is originally from Springfield, Mo. She graduated from Missouri State University with a Bachelor of Science in Music Education. Amanda played horn with the Minnesota Symphonic Winds and completed her master's degree in educational leadership from Saint Mary's University of Minnesota.

Ms. Kremer conducted with the Greater Twin Cities Youth Symphony for three years, and prior to that was a GTCYS sectional coach for several years. 
